Eternal Flame is a group exhibition on view online at [Project Gallery V](#) from January 1st to February 28th, 2021.

As we welcome in the new year, we also beckon in a new collection of artists and their works. *Eternal Flame*, curated by artist and guest curator Cara Lynch, draws inspiration from the famous Yule log of the long-celebrated winter holiday season. The works in the show flicker for a love lost, memorialize a moment of ritual, burn with desire, warn us of impending disaster, remind us of our own mortality, and offer new possibilities as we rise from the ashes of 2020.

The works are on view with courtesy of the artists, and through the generous permission of the LeRoy Neiman Center for Print Studies at Columbia University, Wingate Studios, and Dieu Donné.

This is the second exhibition within the year long online project: Project Gallery V, which was established in September of 2020 by Cary Hulbert and Trinity Lester. Maintaining the goals of the previous show, Project Gallery V is geared towards providing a virtual space for emerging artists to exhibit alongside established artists. We are committed to breaking down the arbitrary boundaries between artistic practices and supporting artists in every part of their professional creative career.
